

Sale Pistol Club Covid Restrictions

From 21st June 2020

The range is open for shooting with the following restrictions. Failure to comply with these rules may result in an infringement under the Chief Health Officer Rules.

These restrictions will change, but only in increments. Please read whole document.

1. Do not come to the range if you have any symptoms of Coronavirus or the Flu. You will be directed to leave the range if you do. Symptoms include; fever, dry cough, tiredness, aches and pains, sore throat, diarrhoea, conjunctivitis, headache, loss of taste or smell, a rash on skin, or discolouration of fingers or toes, difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, chest pain or pressure or loss of speech or movement. You will be temperature checked when entering the complex.
2. The toilets should be used with a cleaning regime ie before and after. Paper towel dispensers are installed in each cubicle with a spray bottle of disinfectant so users of the facility can clean it easily. The wash basin and hand sanitizer available on the range is to be used regularly by everyone on the range. The club firearms are not available at this stage.
3. Numbers. 20 is it and the definition under the rules from the Victorian Chief Health Officer makes it clear that the whole range is included in the definition. Here I make the point that the range is not open to socialise (social distancing and stay at home policy applies. Alcohol cannot be sold at this stage.) Attendance at the range by more than 20 members is an offence. You must pre-register for any day you wish to use the range with the Secretary. This will be modified as restrictions ease.
4. Members attending the range have been mindful of the restrictions. Range timetable will revert to the Saturday timetable (08:00-10:00 for IPSC, 10:00-12:00 for ISSF match of the day, with the afternoon by majority agreement). Syllabus available on the SPC Website.
5. All matches on Range 3 are limited to 4 bays separated by a vacant bay. At all times when not in a bay, members will maintain the 1.5 meter spacing. Shooters when not participating can wait on Range 4. A steel fire pit is now available.

6. One person from each detail must be nominated to record all scores shot to limit the frequency paper on the range is touched by members.
7. All Members attending the range will maintain their own yearly member attendance record (to be given to Secretary before the end of the calendar year,) and **MUST** place a sign on chit into the mailbox on the clubroom door. This is a requirement under the Firearms Act **and** the Chief Health Officer Rules. The sign on chits are available from the club's secretary and website.
8. The club secretary must be advised if you intend to visit the range and when. This can be done by phone, SMS or email. Please add your name to the attendance advice. Members of the Sale Pistol Club are the only persons to attend the range complex during the Covid 19 restrictions. Contact details for the Secretary are available on the SPC website.
9. The matches shot will revert to the 3rd Quarter Syllabus as published.
